

NWISL POLICY 113

SUBJECT: SIDELINE PROTOCOL

When sideline behavior before and during any game is contrary to the rules and philosophies of NWISL and IYSA for the good of soccer, the following progressive discipline will be administered by the respective Coach at the direction of the Head Referee:

1. First Violation = stoppage of play (but not a stoppage of the clock) and a verbal warning administered by the respective Coach to the individual/s
2. Second Violation (by the same Club's sideline) = stoppage of play (but not stoppage of the clock), issuance of formal yellow card to respective Coach and the requirement of that Coach to go to the sideline and warn the individual/s that the next Violation will result in complete stoppage of play and forfeiture of the game.
3. Third Violation (by the same Club's sideline during the same game) = final stoppage of play and forfeiture of game.

In support and reinforcement of this policy, each NWJSL parent shall be required to Execute a formal "Code of Conduct Agreement" as published and administered by their respective Club.
